



XVI. All Munich Rounds, 12 – 14 March 2020

- The Ludwig Maximilian University and the Munich Center for Dispute Resolution are happy to host the XVI. All Munich Rounds from 12 – 14 March 2020.
- **The project “All Munich Rounds” – goals and experiences:** Founded in 2005, the All Munich Rounds are the traditional Munich pre-moot for the oral pleadings held at the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot. Teams from several universities all over the world will meet and practice pleading for this year’s case in a friendly and competitive environment, with the oral hearings in Vienna and Hong Kong serving as a model.

The fifteenth Munich practice rounds were held in March 2019 and 20 teams from England, Germany, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Turkey, Slovenia, Italy, Serbia, Japan, Ukraine, and Sweden participated while over 50 practitioners functioned as arbitrators. With the success of last year’s All Munich rounds in mind, we look forward to the 16th edition of the Munich pre-moot next spring and hope that the encounter between the teams from different universities will once again provide for an intensive and efficient preparation for the competitions in Vienna and Hong Kong.

- **The organization** of the Munich Pre Moot is in the hands of the Munich Center for Dispute Resolution at the Ludwig Maximilian University, led by Prof. Dr. Wolfgang Hau.
- **The target group** of the All Munich Rounds are motivated teams from all over the world who share the passion and enthusiasm for this competition, thus creating the “moot spirit” which makes the All Munich Rounds

a successful pre-moot. We expect the participation

of approximately 20 teams and hope for your understanding that we will not be able to provide a final list of the participating teams before the end of January 2020.

- **The panels** will be composed of lawyers, professors, research assistants, former moot participants and coaches.
- You will find a provisional **schedule** of the All Munich Rounds on the following page. Registered teams will receive a detailed schedule until January 2020.
- The practice rounds will be accompanied by **social events**, allowing the participants to get to know each other and to enjoy Munich.
- You will find a **registration form** on page 3 of this letter. Please submit your registration by **6 December 2019** This enables us to conduct a thorough organization and should still give all interested teams enough time to coordinate their plans and funding. In case you and your team decide to come and visit us it is recommended that you register as soon as possible, since the number of applications usually exceeds the number of teams we can host. Furthermore, we hope you understand that **we will not be able guarantee participation upon receipt of your registration form but will inform you immediately after the closing of the registration process.** We also ask for your understanding that in order to maintain the quality of the All Munich Rounds we must ask participating teams to pay a **registration fee** of EUR 100. Further information on the payment

will be provided upon confirmation of participation.
